A ripe, expansive wine, the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Brenda's Vineyard manages to be both of those things without losing a sense of structure or varietal identity. Black cherries and cassis lead the way, with subtle hints of sage and mint, all framed by gentle shadings of cedar and vanilla. It's full-bodied and velvety in feel, concentrated and flavorful without being overbearing or inelegant, with a long, streamlined finish.

From a Coombsville site, the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Ruppert is distinctly different from the other Cabernets at Baldacci, offering up hints of pine needles and resinous herbs alongside blueberry and blackberry fruit. It's full-bodied and reasonably structured without being hard or unyielding, managing to combine early approachability with at least a decade of cellaring potential.
