## 2021 Diamond Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon

### Diamond Mountain District | Napa Valley

#### The Wine

Sourced from Block 3 of our Stella Knight Vineyard, nestled at the base of the Diamond Mountain District, this wine is a standalone expression of the unique qualities of this appellation. The porous soil and steep slope of Block 3 reduce water retention and challenge the vines to deepen their search for moisture, subtly infusing the grapes with minerality. Given the fruit's robust concentration and texture, I favor a higher new oak usage, embracing the wine's boldness and ensuring its character fully emerges.

#### The 2021 Growing Season

The 2021 vintage was a personal milestone for me as it marked a decade of winemaking at my family's winery. A smooth growing season with low precipitation yielded smaller grapes with intensely concentrated flavors and smaller yields per vine. Quality was high across the board and the wines are approachable and complex now, with the concentration and structure to age.

#### **Tasting Notes**

The Diamond Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon expertly balances power and elegance. It unfolds with aromas of red berries, underscored by subtle notes of dark chocolate and cedar. On the palate, black currant and ripe plum flavors are accented with hints of black tea and a touch of spice. The wine's remarkable structure is supported by firm tannins and a lingering finish, showcasing the distinctive terroir of the Diamond Mountain District. Its complexity and depth make it a standout choice for those seeking a wine with both immediate appeal and age-worthy potential.
